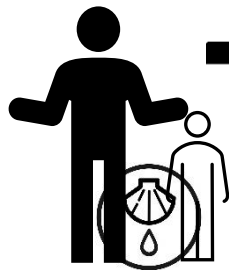


Think about Paul's big question: "Why not sin so grace may increase?" How does verses 1-4 begin to answer that?

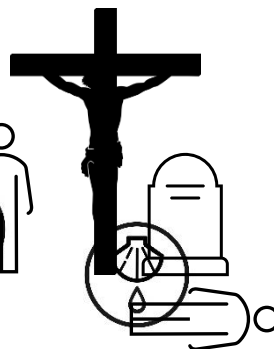
Read Romans 6:5-9

Jesus' Risen Life



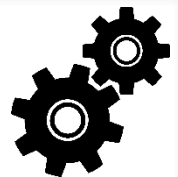
